HARLEM LITTLE LEAGUE MANAGERS AND COACHES UNIFORM POLICY & PROTEST POLICY

<u>Uniforms Managers and Coaches</u>

- Managers and Coaches are required to wear a HLL issued hat and shirt during games. NO EXCEPTIONS TO THE DRESS CODE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL BY HLL.
 - A. First offense will result in Manager or Coach not being allowed to manage or coach the game.
 - B. Second offense will result in Manager or Coach not being allowed to manage or coach the game and suspension from the next game.
 - C. Third offense will result in Manager or Coach being suspended for the remainder of the season.

ONLY HLL ISSUED PLAYER UNIFORMS (HAT, SHIRT,) ARE TO BE WORN DURING GAMES. Scorekeeper is exempt.

GAME PROTEST PROCEDURES

- An umpire is notified of protest and signs both teams game day page of scorebooks.
- Umpire gives both scorebooks to division coordinator.
- Protesting manager puts in writing a formal protest within 24 hours to The President of HLL. If game takes place on Saturday protesting manager has until 5pm Monday to file formal protest with the President of HLL. No protest will be reviewed if filed after 24 hours.

ALL PROTEST WILL BE RESOLVED BEFORE THE NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED GAME.
